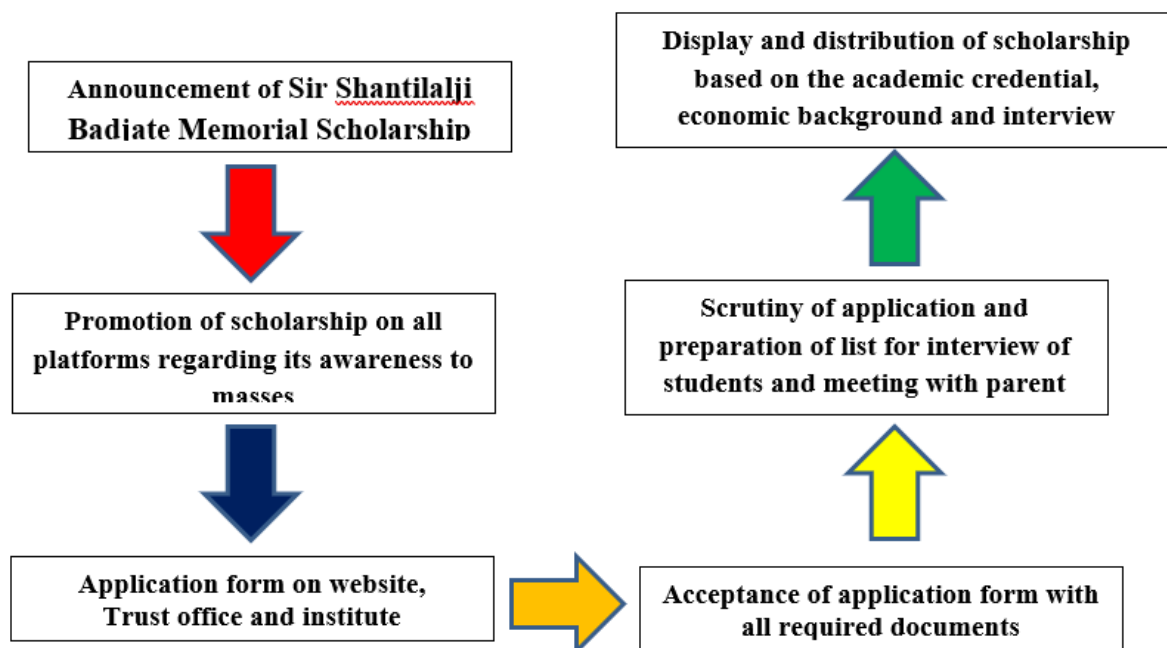


Figure – Flow chart of selection of students based For Sir Shantilalji Badjate Memorial Scholarship
